



Changes to Services at Albury Wodonga Aboriginal Health Service

GP Appointments— as of the 30th of March all GP appointments will be via telephone unless your doctor has advised you to come to AWAHS for a face to face appointment.

What happens if you need a script or a referral? Don't worry we have this organised for you! Our amazing reception girls can either fax these off to where they need to go whether that's a chemist, specialist etc. OR you will have the option of being able to pick up these at our screen-ing desk at the entrance of AWAHS doors.

Midwifery appointments— Antenatal patients that will need to attend the service for certain appointments will be advised to do so otherwise it will be a telephone consult.

Dental Appointments— To help limit the spread of COVID- 19, the Government has placed heavy restrictions on the provision of dental services. AWAHS is now limited to providing **ONLY high priority emergency** dental services to those patients in **severe pain** resulting from swelling/trauma/Abscess or persistent ulcers in the face/neck or mouth region. All other elective and non- urgent treatments have now been postponed. We will be only contacting patients who have already been booked for *urgent* care. Should your condition change, we advise you to contact us on 6040 1200.

Allied Health Appointment

Podiatry — patients will continue to be seen at AWAHS by our podiatrist Lauren unless advised otherwise.

Speech — patients will receive a phone call for their appointment for all Initial and existing patients from our Speechy Edwina.

Dietician— patients will receive a phone call for their appointment from our dietician Susie.

Diabetes Educator— patients will receive a phone call for their appointment with Lauren unless advised otherwise.

Psychologist— Patient will receive a phone call for their appointment unless advised otherwise

Social Worker— patients will receive a phone call for their appointment from our Social Worker Bec.

Chronic Disease Team— Appointments will be a telephone appointment unless otherwise ad-vised by your worker.

CFHN Appointments - children needing immunisations will be seen at AWAHS in our Imms Clinic which will be on a Tuesday and a Thursday a from 10am—3pm with our child and fam-ily health nurse. Health check appointments however will be done over the telephone.

Social Emotional Wellbeing Team— All appointments with your worker will be by telephone unless discussed to come into the service.

Centrelink Outreach — appointments will be unfortunately on hold until further notice.
